He was born in 1957 in Novi Sad, Serbia. He completed his education in economics by shuttling between the Universities of Novi Sad, Belgrade, Amsterdam and Queen's University (Kingston, Ontario). Throughout the 1980s he worked on and off in the oil business, most notably in the Middle East. During that time he also studied with the help of grants from both the Dutch and Canadian governments.
